At all times you are expected to set the example in appearance, discipline, integrity, knowledge, drill proficiency, and of course the Army values. In order to succeed there must be an understanding of what is right and what is wrong. Along with that comes consistency and hard work, especially when reaching for a national title (Daytona Beach, Florida).

This driller swears to uphold the principles of being on the Pioneer Guard Drill Team and understands that violations of these principles will result in dismissal from the team. This driller will perform all expected duties and conduct team related matters with responsibilities and pride. We are one team and will act as such.

Responsibilities of all members of the Pioneer Guard Drill Team are as follows:

- 1. I will represent this team in the best way I can, on and off of the drill floor.
- 2. I will respect my teammates and treat each one of them in a professional manner.
- 3. I will report any concerns to my Pioneer Guard Commander. CDT/ 1LT Miller
- 4. I will wear the designated Pioneer Guard uniform on days when it is established (practices, drill meets, etc.)
- 5. I will be responsible for all equipment designated to me.
- 6. I will work my hardest every day at practice and approach new things with an open mind.
- 7. I will show up to practice with a good attitude and on time every morning (0545 0700), in my black shorts, black shirt and drill shoes.

Suspension/Removal from the team will be taken into effect if the following occurs:

- 1. Disrespecting teammates, on or off the drill floor.
- 2. 10 + missed practices (does not include excused absences)
- 3. Engaging in illegal activities.
- 4. Other special circumstances that may arise will be dealt with accordingly.

Social Media and Group Chat Policy.

The only people that should post in the GROUPME chat are the designated commanders. Questions may be posted by cadets but are to be answered by the Pioneer Guard Commander. Unnecessary information/responses will be kept out of the group chat. Social media posts/usage is to remain positive and encouraging at all times. There will be a no-gossiping tolerance on this team. Engaging in drama is a choice, don't be a part of it.

Traveling Requirements.

NOT ALL MEMBERS will be traveling to events. 20 starters + 5 alternates will be taken to drill meets and nationals in Daytona Beach, Florida. To travel you must be a cadet with good conduct, have no more than 1 D in PowerSchool, and be an active participating member of the team. Grades will be checked the week of an event and your alternate will be put in your place as needed. Grades will be enforced so do not be in danger of not traveling.
